

NEW NATIONAL COUNCILLORS

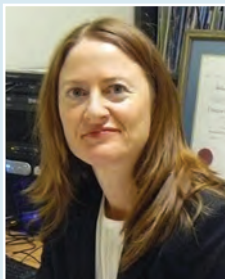
